#### **DESCRIPTION**

SAFeR is an approach to decision-making in Family Law matters. Using this framework, we can improve the safety and outcomes for domestic violence survivors and their children. SAFeR consists of four steps: (1) Screening for violence; (2) Assessing the full nature and context of the violence; (3) Focusing on effects of the violence; and (4) Responding to the lived experience of the violence.
